### **Position Overview:**

This position reports to the *Director of Education* and provides a positive learning environment using developmentally appropriate ways when teaching participants of the Dowd Education Center learning extension programs.

## **Key Responsibilities:**

- Provides a caring environment to assist children with their homework, academic enrichment, youth development and social emotional learning
- Provides an environment for children to develop socially and behaviorally, as well as academically
- · Maintains accurate daily and monthly records on each child
- Reports the need for any academic or behavioral intervention needs
- Participates and helps supervise the children during events
- · Accompanies and supervises children attending special programming
- Completes accurate documentation of a child's progress academically, socially and behaviorally
- Makes copies of homework when needed and report cards when possible

- BS/BA in Education/Early Childhood Education/Education Administration preferred;

- Minimum of two years' working with at-risk children
